Event Map

The Tokyo 2021 competition venues will be spread across two zones in Tokyo.

The “Heritage Zone”, which encompasses Tokyo’s city center, the Imperial Palace, and the financial district, will be the epicenter for events like opening/closing ceremonies, athletics, table tennis, boxing, weightlifting, judo, karate, and equestrian.

The “Tokyo Bay Zone”, located southeast of Tokyo’s city center and symbolizing the exciting future of the city, will host events like gymnastics, aquatics, tennis, volleyball, basketball, and beach volleyball.

The Olympic Village is positioned at the point where the two zones intersect. Both zones are well connected with public transportation, making it easy to navigate between venues.

Prefectures outside of Tokyo like Saitama, Miyagi, Sapporo, and others will also play host to Olympics events like baseball, softball, and football, offering travelers an opportunity to explore other parts of Japan. Approximate travel times between Tokyo and these other prefectures using high speed trains (Shinkansen) are as follows:

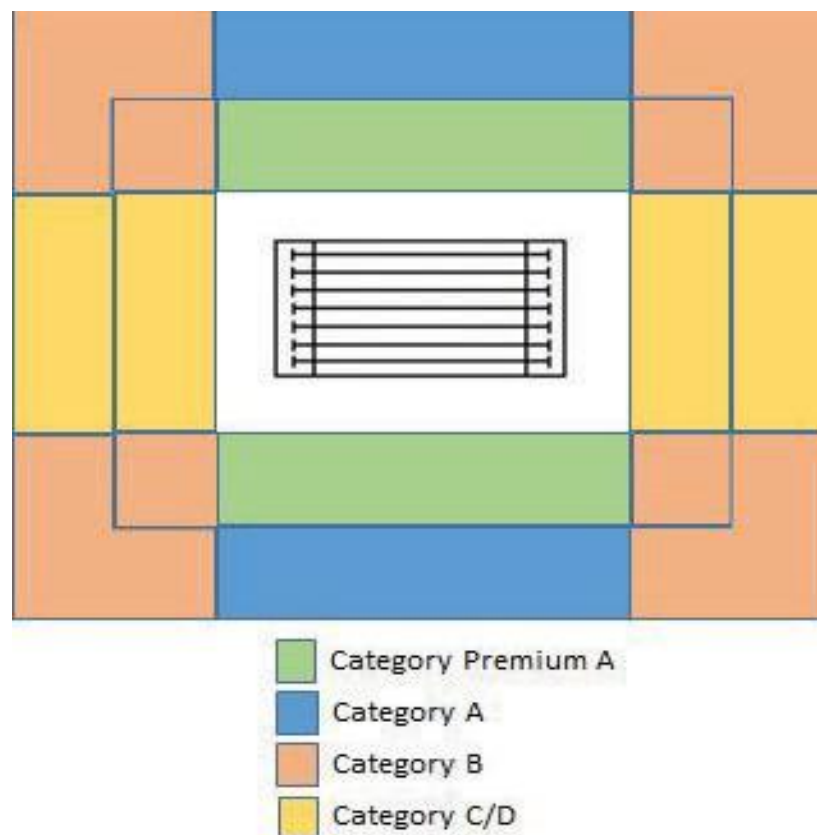
Each stadium hosting an Olympic competition event during the Tokyo Summer Olympic Games will be set up differently depending on the event. The Olympic Committee has designated seating at each stadium into 4 separate seating categories (Category A, B, C and D).

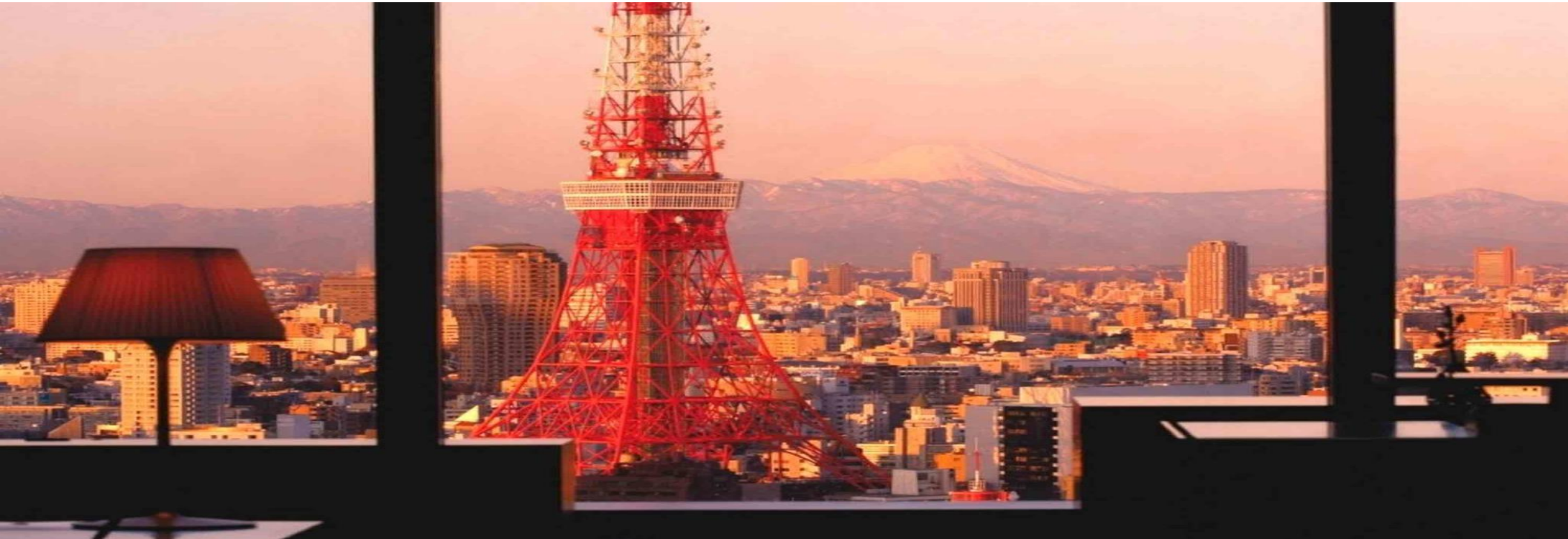
Please note that because these designations can be very broad, On Point Events has decided to subdivide the seating categories as follows:

Premium Category A	These are Category A seats located in the most prime areas of the stadium, along the sidelines and in the lower level. This category may not be available for all Events.
Category A	Generally located along the sidelines upper or lower level
Category B	Generally located in the corners upper or lower level
Category C/D	Entry level seating to the event. Generally located on the ends either upper or lower level

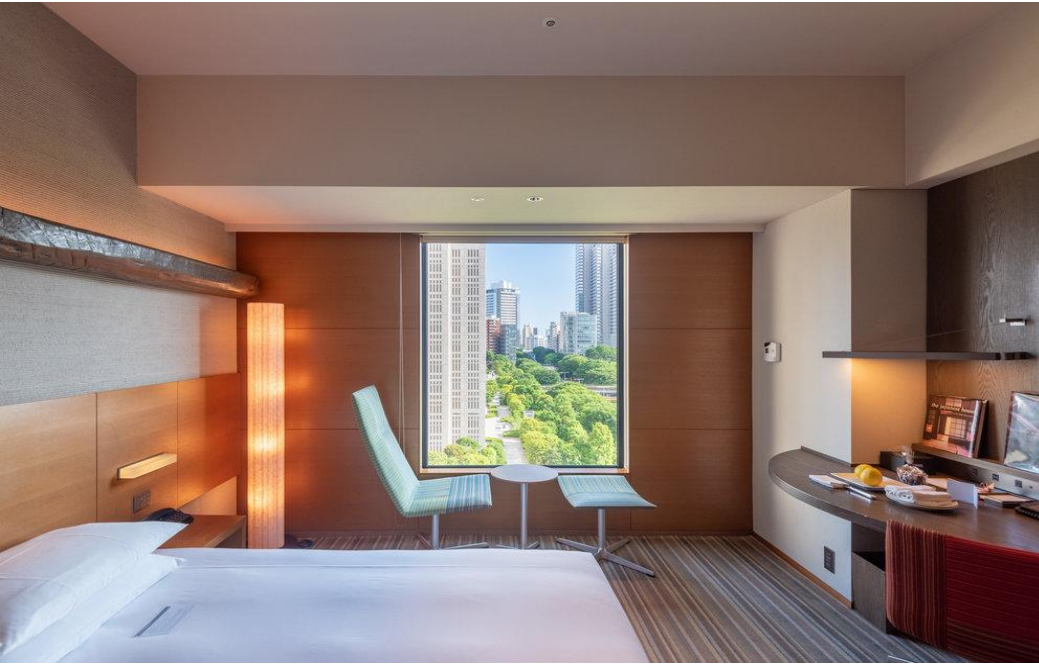

Asakusa Tour

Start your tour with a stop to Asakusa, Tokyo's old town where you can soak in the atmosphere of historic Tokyo. Visit Sensoji, Tokyo's oldest temple, and wander down Nakamise, a shopping street that has been providing temple visitors with a variety of traditional, local snacks and tourist souvenirs for centuries.



Harajuku/Meiji Shrine Tour

Start your day with a walk through Omotesando, a broad, tree lined avenue sometimes referred to as Tokyo's Champs-Elysees featuring a multitude of fashion flagship stores designed by internationally renowned architects. Then head to Harajuku, the mecca for Japanese youth. Takeshita-dori street is world famous for showcasing unusual fashion as well as trendy dessert stands. Finish your tour nearby at the Meiji Shrine, one of Japan's most popular shrines, located in a tranquil forest made of 100,000 trees.

Garden and Park Tour

Start the tour at the Hama Rikyu, a lush landscape garden in the middle of Tokyo’s skyscrapers. Next head off to the Imperial Palace Gardens, which includes nostalgic castle moats and the foundations of the former castle tower. Finish your tour at Ueno Park which houses half a dozen museums, a zoo, a Toshogu Shrine, and the Shinobazu Pond.



Unique Side of Tokyo Tour

Discover a side of Tokyo you won’t see in most guidebooks. Start with a trip to Akihabara, known as Japan’s “Electric Town”. See the bright lights of Tokyo’s tech area with sky high tech stores such as Yodobashi Akiba. Then, stop at an animal café such as a cat café or owl café. Lastly, finish your tour with a stop by the famous Shabuya Crossing, one of the busiest intersections in the world with thousands of people crossing at one time – it is a must see in Tokyo!

Nightlife Tour

Start your tour in Golden Gai, an area located in east Shinjuku and famous for its many bars. Most are so tiny it can only seat four to five customers at a time. Each bar offers its own unique atmosphere and most even feature an odd theme. Next, experience how the local “salarymen” unwind after a long day at the office in the maze of Shimbashi eateries, izakayas, and standing bars.



Culinary Tours

Start your tour with a walk through the historic Tsukiji Fish Market – with over 300 shops and restaurants offering a variety of fresh produce and a lively atmosphere. Explore the plethora of seafood stalls while fitting between boxes packed with sea urchins and other delicacies. Next, you’ll stop by a few local spots to try some other types of Japanese cuisine such as yakatori, tempura, Teppanyaki, and ramen.

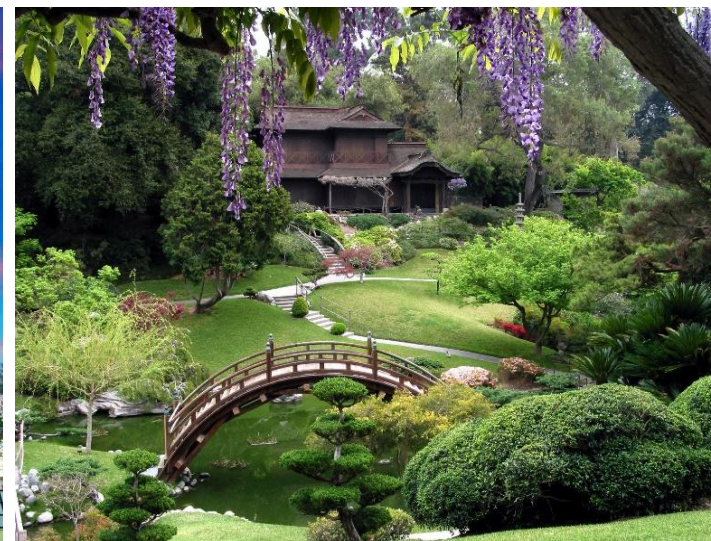
