The only tickets legally permitted for resale at Wimbledon are Debenture tickets (Purple Section), offering exceptional “club-level” viewing on par with the Royal Box. Centre Court Debenture seats are located in the prestigious 200 gangways and select front rows of the 300 gangways, delivering outstanding sightlines and comfort.

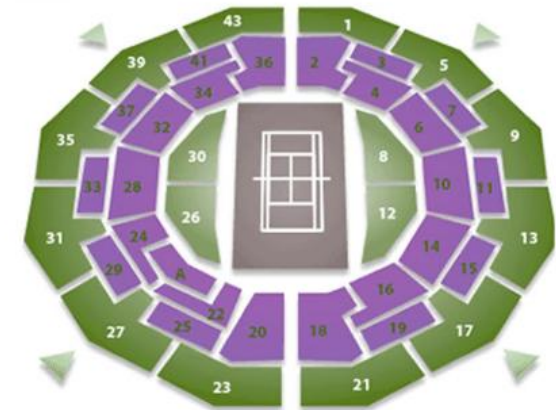
Centre Court Debenture tickets are valid for the full day's play and include access to unreserved seating on the outside courts throughout the All England Lawn Tennis Club grounds.

Court 1 Debenture tickets provide admission to all sessions on Court 1, along with access to unreserved seating on the outside courts.

All Debenture tickets also grant daily entry to exclusive Debenture Holder lounges, featuring private restaurants, premium bars, dedicated restrooms, and additional upscale amenities.

Baseline, South Side: Shaded early in the afternoon
Sideline, West Side: Begins to receive shade by late afternoon

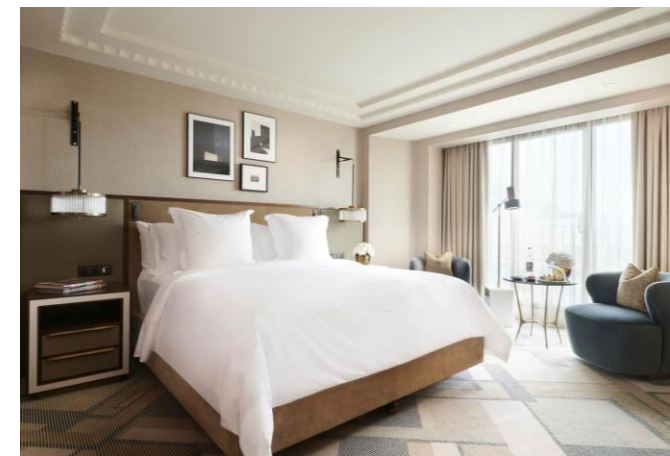


Four Seasons Park Lane

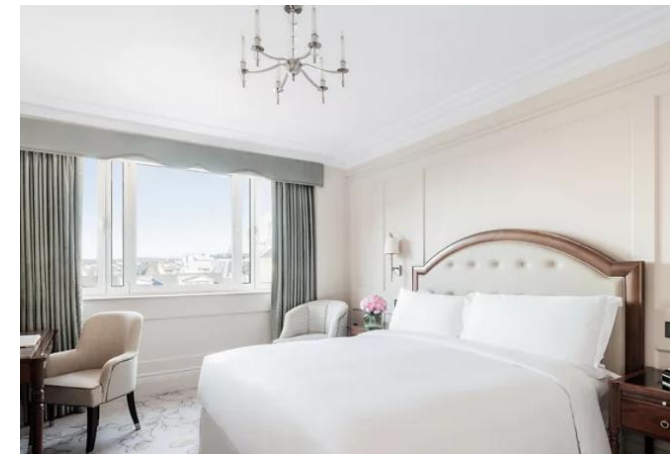
