# Event Map

The Beijing 2022 competition venues will be spread across three zones:

## Beijing Cluster (city):

Located in central Beijing, this cluster is expected to be home to 12 venues including several existing structures from the 2008 Summer Games. Many of the venues are located in the Olympic Green area — the hub of the action. Winter Games events in the Beijing cluster will primarily be the ice sports: skating, hockey, and curling. This is also the location for the opening and closing ceremonies.

## Yanqing Cluster (nearby mountains):

Yanqing is a mountainous suburb of Beijing, located approximately **75 kilometers** northwest of the city center. Yanqing is a scenic area with ski resorts, hot springs, national parks, and one of the most popular sections of the Great Wall: Badaling. In 2022, it will host the alpine skiing events as well as the sliding events: bobsled, luge, and skeleton.

## Zhangjiakou Cluster (mountains 3 hours away):

Located in a burgeoning tourist area, Zhangjiakou is well known as a popular Chinese ski destination with plenty of other activities and cultural attractions for visitors to enjoy. Zhangjiakou is approximately 180 kilometers northwest of Beijing, but a newly constructed high-speed train route will transfer guests between the two cities in just **50 minutes**. The Zhangjiakou Cluster will feature a majority of the ski and snowboard events at the 2022 Winter Games including freestyle, cross country, ski jumping, Nordic combined, and biathlon.

# Ticket Categories

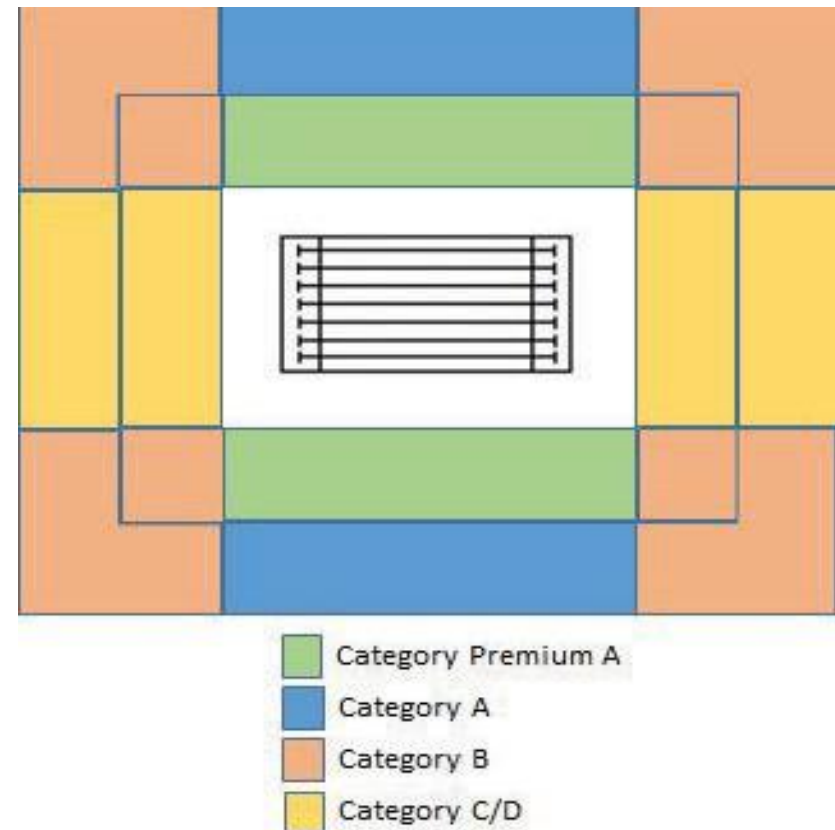
Each stadium hosting an Olympic competition event during the Beijing Winter Olympics Games will be set up differently depending on the event. The Olympic Committee has designated seating at each stadium into 4 separate seating categories (category A, B, C and D).

Please note that because these designations can be very broad, On Point Events has decided to subdivide the seating categories as follows:

<b>Category Premium A</b>	These are Category A seats located in the most prime areas of the stadium, on the sides and in the lower level. This category may not be available for all events.
<b>Category A</b>	Generally located on the sides upper or mid-level
<b>Category B</b>	Generally located on the sides upper or mid-level
<b>Category C/D</b>	Entry level seating to the event. Generally located on the ends, either upper or lower level

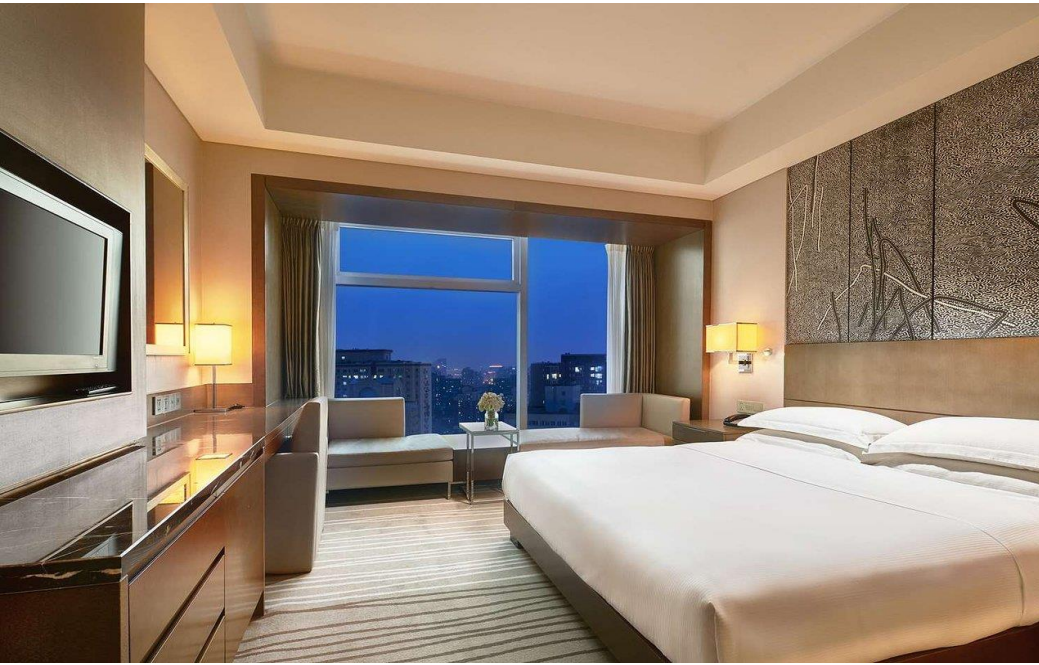

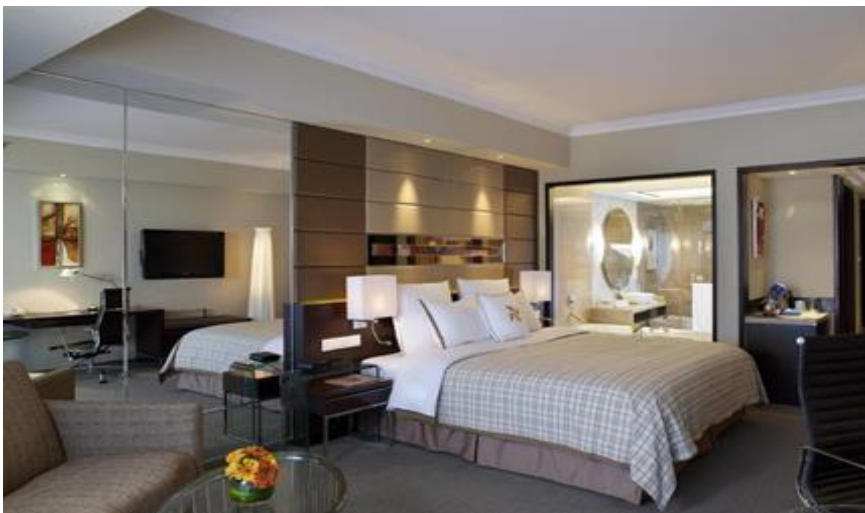

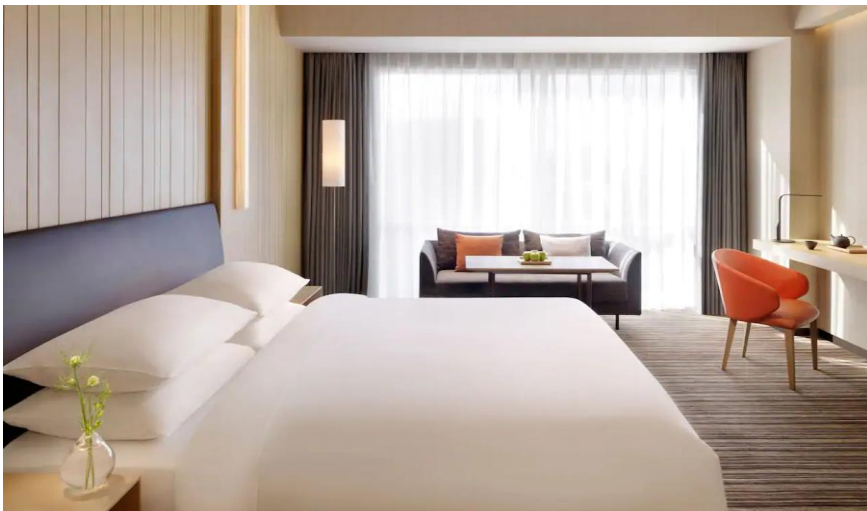

# Beijing Experiences



## Private Helicopter Tour of the Great Wall of China

Rising from China's forested mountaintops, the Great Wall ranks among the world's most impressive architectural works. View one of the most scenic and best-preserved sections of the Great Wall of China, the Mutianyu segment, by air, to appreciate the grandness. Then, by land, to hike and experience this majestic structure with an expert guide who will fill you in on the wall's rich and complicated past. A local chef-inspired picnic lunch will be served atop the Great Wall for you to enjoy.



## Explore Beijing Olympic Park

Head to Beijing Olympic Park. Here you can see the Herzog & de Meuron designed National Stadium, better known as the Bird's Nest, which features an exterior crafted from 42,000 tons of steel. Nearby, look for the National Aquatics Center, better known as the Water Cube, where Michael Phelps set his world records. During the day, you can go inside both venues; you can pay to ride a Segway around the Bird's Nest track for 20 minutes or go to a water park constructed inside the Water Cube after the games concluded. If you only care about seeing the structures from the outside, it's best to visit the park at night, when both are illuminated.

# Beijing Experiences



## Confucius Temple Tour

Built in 1302, the Confucius Temple pays tribute to China's greatest sage and his lasting legacy. The temple is unique in the sense that it is dedicated to a mortal rather than a deity; regardless, worshippers come here to offer gifts and sacrifices much like those seen at Buddhist and Taoist temples. The Hall of Great Accomplishment contains Confucius's funeral tablet, while the Hall of Great Perfection features the central shrine to the scholar and a large collection of ancient musical instruments. In the front and main courtyards of the temple stand rows of stone tablets inscribed with more than 50,000 names of those who passed imperial examinations during the Yuan, Ming, and Qing dynasties.



## Lama Temple Tour

Originally built as a temple for Prince Yongzheng, who went on to become the third Qing Dynasty Emperor, Lama Temple is one of the most important functioning Buddhist temples in Beijing. Although it once housed as many as 500 resident monks, today the complex is home to around two dozen, but that doesn't detract from the splendor of the five main halls and multiple galleries hung with *thangkas* (Tibetan scroll paintings). Lama Temple is best visited at a slow pace, but if you're short on time, make sure you don't skip the Pavilion of Ten Thousand Fortunes, inside which stands an awe-inspiring, 85-foot Buddha carved from a single piece of sandalwood.

# Beijing Experiences



## Explore the Forbidden City

The Imperial Palace, also known as the Forbidden City, is China's most significant attraction and can trace its origins back to the Yuan Dynasty of the 13th century. Its immense size is the result of enlargements made during the Ming Dynasty between 1406 and 1420, after the capital was transferred here from Nanking. All told, this beautiful palace has been home to 24 Ming and Qing Emperors, earning its nickname of the Forbidden City because ordinary citizens weren't allowed access.



## The Temple of Heaven

Southeast of the Forbidden City, the Temple of Heaven remains one of the most important examples of Chinese religious architecture. For centuries, this is where emperors made sacrifices to the gods in hopes of achieving a fruitful harvest. (A series of bad harvests could be interpreted by the people as a sign to overthrow the emperor, so this ritual was taken very seriously.) Twice the size of the Forbidden City, the temple's grounds are home to many fine Ming Dynasty buildings, but the hallmark structure, the Hall of Prayer for Good Harvests, is a visual knockout. Standing atop a three-tiered marble base, this magnificent, blue-roofed, circular building is supported entirely by 28 pillars and not a single nail.

# Beijing Experiences



## Wander the Dashilar Area

This traditional hutong area to the south of Tiananmen Square is one of the few areas that still looks like it might have in the ancient days of Beijing. Rather than being bulldozed like so many other hutongs, the Dashilar area has held onto a local character and beautiful original architecture. After taking in the grandeur of Beijing's central square, Dashilar is a more intimate area to get lost in and to take a walk into the past.



## See Summer Palace

Get a glimpse at how the imperial family once spent its leisure time, in this 700-acre royal retreat commissioned by Emperor Qianlong in 1750. Many of the original structures here were ransacked and burned in 1860, but the Summer Palace was renovated by the unscrupulous Empress Dowager Cixi, until her death in 1908. She even made the Summer Palace (rather than the Forbidden City) the official seat of government during the last five years of her life.

# Beijing Experiences



## Tour Tiananmen Square

One of the world's largest public squares, where Mao Zedong announced the founding of the People's Republic of China on October 1, 1949 and the location of the tragic massacre of student demonstrators in June 1989. The best way to see Tiananmen Square is to start at Qianmen, a historic gate located at the southern end of the square. Moving north, you'll pass Mao Zedong Memorial Hall, where the Great Helmsman's embalmed body is displayed in a crystal case, and the Monument to the People's Heroes, a 125-foot granite obelisk dedicated to those who died for the revolutionary cause of the Chinese people.



## Culinary Tours

Eat your way through China's culinary history, its regional cuisines, and the brilliant dishes crafted by China's most cutting-edge chefs. Stroll, sip, sample street snacks, and savor all that Beijing has to offer in secret alleyway spots and uncover the excitement of elixir bars where locals go to unwind and play.

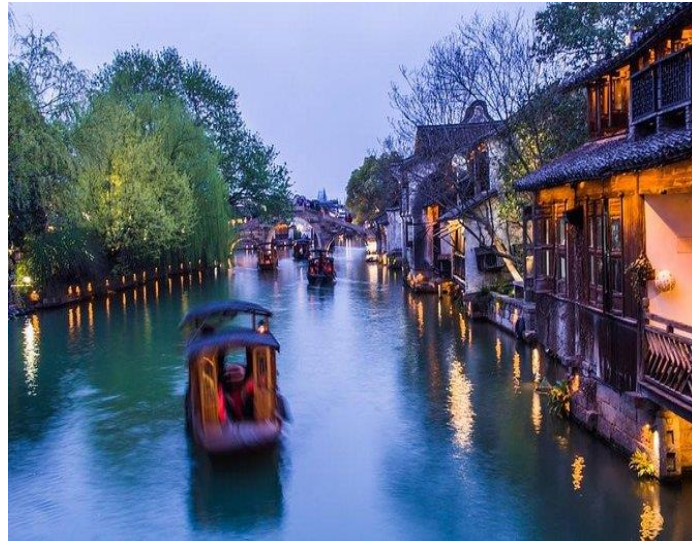
